Hi Guys you are all invited to the first Chukar challenge at Stonewall Boarding and Game Preserve. We will also serve lunch. I think we will have a blast come and find out! Read on and find out more, if you may be interested let me know

I would like to put on this year the first ever Stonewall Chukar Challenge, where the average hunter competes with his dog and somebody will walk away with some money from the amateur, doubles and puppy division. For once you and your dog's hunting skills may pay for your birds and then some. The event objectives are "good" dog work, "good" marksmanship, a bit of luck, and lots of fun. If any of you are interested let me know as I am going to do this and you guys came to preserve last year so I want to give you first chance. More then likely we will have to limit the entries, but I thought this would be a blast and I hope you do too. I am not sure when more then likely after duck season and not during deer season close. Training Collars are allowed, but with in reason.

Tom Glynn has agreed to come and give a demo on how this is done. So we will run two dogs in the morning to show how this goes. Tom will also give a talk about the rules. Here is Tom's web page [http://www.nybds.net/Tournament\\_Hunting.php](http://www.nybds.net/Tournament_Hunting.php).

Entry fee includes your shells, Coffee and donuts in the morning, hot lunch at noon. If you have a dog and not a partner for the doubles we will place the people name in the hat and draw partner for you.

#### Entry Fees:

\$100 Amateur Divisions (\$25 returned to prize money)

\$150 Doubles Divisions (\$25 returned to prize money)

\$75 Puppy Divisions (under 18 months) (\$19 returned to prize money)

\*\*\* Pre- entry is preferred, but not required to run. If time allows in the field and the division has not ended, you are able to register with a \$10 late entry fee applied.

Paybacks 50%, 30%, 20% Example if there 10 handlers and dogs 1St place will \$125, 2nd place will get \$75 3rd place will get \$50.

In the Amateur Divisions the winner of the division will receive 50% of the cash pot and a 1st place ribbon, 2nd place winner will receive 30% of the cash pot and a ribbon, 3rd place winner will receive 20% of the cash pot and 1st place ribbon.

In the Doubles Division the winner of the division will receive 50% of the cash pot and a 1st place ribbon, the 2nd place winner will receive 30% of the cash pot and a ribbon and the 3rd place winner will receive 20% of the cash pot and a ribbon.

In the Puppy Division the 1st place winner will receive 50% of the cash pot and a 1st place ribbon, the 2nd place winner will receive 30% of the cash pot and a ribbon and the 3rd place winner will receive 20% of the cash pot and a ribbon..

#### Division Descriptions

Amateur Pointing: One hunter, one dog, one 20 minute run, four chukars and eight shells per run. This division is open to anyone including professional handlers and their dogs. The dog must hold point for three seconds.

Amateur Flushing: One hunter, one dog, one 20 minute run, 4 chukars and eight shells per run. This division is open to anyone including professional handlers and their dogs.

Doubles: Two hunters, two dogs, one 25 minute run, six chukars and ten shells per run. A hunter may enter up to six times per event as long as his or her team member changes every time.

Puppy: One hunter, one puppy, one 25 minute run, three Chukar and six shells per run. This division is for dogs up to 18 months of age. You must establish whether the puppy will point or flush at time of entry. All pointing and flushing puppies will compete against each other.

#### **Directions from I90 West**

Exit 29 out of toll plaza take left onto rt5 east it will turn into RT 162 you will go 11.5 miles Stonewall Boarding kennel is on the right.

#### **Directions from New York State Thurway**

Take exit 25A for RT88, Then follow directions from RT88

#### **Directions from RT88 Exit 23 Central Bridge**

From the East make a right hand turn off RT88

From the West make a Left hand turn off RT88

From the light make a left at light.

You are heading RT 7 head west for 1 mile

Make right on RT30A at red barrel head Gas station

You will head north on 30a for 3.5 miles.

You will cross intersection of RT20 and RT162/RT30a.

go straight thru light exactly 1.7 miles

Stonewall Boarding Kennel on left.
